TERMS AND CONDITIONS

PRICES, DEPOSIT, PAYMENT, and CANCELLATION POLICY:

Cost per person double occupancy: \$3950. Bring a friend and take \$50 off your trip cost. 8 participants are required for trip to operate.

Single accommodations are available for a supplemental fee of \$1345..

Costs are based on exchange rates as of January 17, 2012 and are subject to adjustment in the event of any major currency fluctuation.

Above cost includes:

- 8 nights 4 star hotel accommodations inclusive of continental or buffet breakfast as detailed in the itinerary.
- Professional English speaking guides (different in each city) on all tours as stated in the itinerary.
- Welcome Dinner, Farewell Dinner, tastings and lunches as mentioned in the itinerary.
- Reserved seating on the Alta Velocita train from Rome to Florence.
- Professional drivers on sightseeing tours where vehicles are required and transfers to Modena, Padua, and Venice.
- Airport transfers (one arrival and one departure airport transfer for the group at a time mutually convenient to the guests).
- Entry tickets to the Galleria Accademia and the Uffizi in Florence for independent viewing at leisure.
- All entry fees for sights included in the guided tours mentioned in the itinerary.
- Porterage of two pieces of luggage per person
- Gratuities to drivers, porters, restaurants.

The cost does not include:

- International airfare (inquire for available flights and fares)
- Entry visa fees, if any
- Travel and medical insurance
- All soft and alcoholic beverages; house wine is provided at Welcome and Final Dinners and dinners or tastings where indicated.
- All expenses of a personal nature, i.e. laundry, telephone bills, postage etc.

Payments

A \$750 deposit is required by March 15, 2012 to confirm the reservation and is fully refundable less a \$100 service fee if the trip is cancelled up to 90 days before departure. The balance is payable in full May 1, 2012. Cancellation penalties may apply. Space is limited and a deposit will hold your reservation.

Cancellation Policy

For bookings cancelled up to 90 from the date of arrival, 50% of the booking cost will be charged. For bookings cancelled within 45 days from the date of arrival, or "no show", 100% of the total value of the booking will be charged.

A minimum of 8 participants is required for the tour to take place. In the event the minimum is not reached, the total deposit will be returned.

Travel insurance is highly recommended, please inquire for best quote.

Passport and Visa

A valid passport is required for international travel. Your passport must remain valid for at least 6 months beyond the completion of your trip. It is also imperative that your passport has at least 2 blank pages (excluding amendment pages).

Flight check in: All travelers are responsible for informing themselves of the respective airlines check-in requirements and baggage restrictions. Missed or delayed flights resulting in late arrival for the tour shall not result in any reduction or refund of tour cost.

Health/Disability Requirements: All guests are responsible for determining if the trip is suitable for their athletic ability, fitness level, and state of health and are required to report in writing at the time their reservation is made, any physical or mental condition that may require medical or professional treatment during the tour, any condition that may render the traveler unfit for travel or that may require special care or assistance or any condition that may pose a risk or danger to the traveler or any other travelers.
